### 138 PRIME CATTLE

A small post-Easter entry included some better quality butchers cattle forward which met a firm trade. Commercial sorts sold to similar levels to recent weeks with those over 700kg difficult to achieve good pence per kilo! Overall market average 178p/kg.

Our steer entry included many out of spec cattle. Best handy weight steers sold above 200p/kg to 207p/kg or to £1338 in the lump. Best heifers sold to 246p/kg with several others above 230p/kg.

The show of bulls was not the best this morning, with too many too lean for most tastes. Continentals sold to 205p/kg. Holsteins sold to 166p/kg when well-finished.

### 13 COWS SOLD TO AV. 117/KG

Once again, cows look well sold against the rest of the trade. Young Limousin cross cows sold to 156p/kg for 714kg, with others to 149p/kg and 145p/kg. Best meat Holsteins sold to 115p/kg for 716kg. Plain cows sold from 50p/kg to 100p/kg.

### 86 CLEAN CATTLE

21 steers sold to average 176p/kg. A useful run of four Limousins from Gerald Kincaid topped at 207p/kg, with Rita Corfield selling to 202p/kg for 570kg. Charolais sold to 197p/kg for 610kg from Brian Whiteman, with others to 192p/kg from John Cantrill. Friesians to 144p/kg from Tom Davies at 656kg.

65 heifers sold to average 198p/kg, Matt Bower took the honours for his 510kg Limousin at 246p/kg. Stuart Bebb took second spot at 241p/kg for 500kg for a Limousin x Blue and sold others from 229p/kg to 235p/kg. 476kg British Blues from Neil Perkins sold to 234p/kg. Two Continentals from Richard Parkes sold to 232p/kg and 231p/kg.

30 Holstein Friesians were forward plus a sprinkling of Continentals most of which were over 16 months old. A run of well finished Continentals from Roger Tomley sold to 205p/kg and 201p/kg for 584kg and 550kg. Limousins from Craig Evans and Henry Yates sold to 197p/kg for 586kg and 600kg respectively.
