Once again those that were able to take advantage of the general shortage of finished cattle about at this time were well-rewarded. A flying trade on all types and shapes with best quality in shorter supply than recent sales. A full ring of buyers attended with many individuals leaving short of beasts for regular orders.

Very few steers forward saw a tremendous trade selling to 226p/kg for 644kg, with most dairy bred Friesians a flier also to 185p/kg.

Butchers heifers in strong demand selling passed 240p/kg on many occasions to a high of 249p/kg. More commercial sorts very dear with Hereford heifers passed 200p/kg.

The bull trade followed suit with the above with best sucklers to 230p/kg and genuine Holsteins (but good meat) to 196p/kg. MORE BULLS AND CLEAN ARE REQUIRED NEXT WEEK PLEASE KEEP THE BUYERS SUPPLIED IF WE CAN

ONLY 3 COWS met a "good go" with 878kg dry bagged Blue cows to 170p/kg (£1492) and meat Holsteins to 133p/kg for 762kg.
