149 PRIME CATTLE

It was great to see a few more cattle forward but whilst we are always stating this, more cattle could have easily sold on this trade. A real humdinger on all cattle with as good a ring of buyers as we have seen for some time, especially on clean cattle. The last time trade was this good, the supermarkets were trying to get us to eat horse!

More steers were needed with 13 forward selling to a high of 240p/kg or £1310 in the lump. No best heavy bullocks forward. Heifer trade was tremendous selling to 260p/kg with seven others 250p/kg or more. Several buyers left short of cattle which was not a good thing but they will be back next week to have another go. Heavy heifers sold to £1449.

Bull trade held its own once again with best sucklers beginning to run out it appears. Limousins sold to 216p/kg with shape. Friesian/Holsteins with meat looked well sold against the Continentals to 170p/kg.

21 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

An improved cow trade with a new face around the ring taking non-FABBL stock. Best farm assured Blonde cows sold to 154p/kg for 724kg from Tony Barker, with 700kg British Blues to 141p/kg from Peter Raybould, with Roy Kinnish selling to the same for 672kg Blondes. 680kg non-assured Limousins to 139p/kg from LH Wardle. No meat dairy cattle forward with the best available to 98p/kg from Frank Povall. Brown Swiss bulls to 76p/kg from the Ossig camp.

Only 13 steers sold to av. 183p/kg – Handy weight Limousins from Charlie Sandells took the honours here at 240p/kg for 546kg (£1310.40). 570kg Limousins to 197p/kg from Richard Ince. Hereford crosses to 180p/kg from the Truswells.
