208 PRIME CATTLE

With the sudden deluge in rain over recent days, many farmers were encouraged to bring more beasts off the fields and there were larger numbers of grass cattle forward this morning. Trade was a little easier as reported by Monday centres to average 198p/kg all through.

More steers were entered selling to a high of 233p/kg on two occasions and achieving £1523.24 in the lump.

Heifer trade saw the best a little easier but there was still plenty of competition for these to 252p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1506.72 per head. There were several non-assured cattle and several over 36 months of age.

A lack lustre bull trade saw bulls that were too lean and hard to sell. Best Continentals sold to 227p/kg. Holsteins sold to 170p/kg, with Montbeliardes to 195p/kg.

24 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS SOLD TO AV. 109P/KG

Young Holstein meat cows took the headlines on a more difficult trade at 145p/kg for 652kg, with others to 127p/kg. Limousin cows sold to 125p/kg for 734kg. Limousin stock bulls sold to 110p/kg and 111p/kg around the 900kg mark and lean. Plain cows a fair trade for the goods.

165 CLEAN CATTLE

40 steers sold to average 196p/kg. Trade easier in this department but the very best still held their own as Robert Turner's two shapey Limousins both achieved 233p/kg for 632kg and 636kg, with others to 228p/kg from the same stable. Victor Davies sold Lims to 228p/kg for 666kg, with others to 222p/kg also from Dave Chilton for 530kg, with Charolais 650kg to 221p/kg from John Elgin. 674kg sold to £1523.14 again for Mr Turner.

125 heifers sold to average 207p/kg. British Blues from Miss Kirkham took the headlines at 252p/kg for 478kg, with other Blues to 251p/kg for 504kg from George Morris with another to 249p/kg from the same stable. Richard Parkes' nice run topped at 249p/kg for two Limmie crosses at 478kg and 502kg. 508kg Lims sold to 248p/kg from Roger Jordin. 688kg Blondes from Mr Williams added up to £1506.72.

43 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 175P/KG.

26 Holsteins, Ayrshires etc. are included in the above average. Shapey 580kg and 570kg British Blue x Limousins sold to 227p/kg and 224p/kg both from George Morris. 642kg Limousins sold to 215p/kg from Paul Taylor, with Phil Roberts' 562kg Blue to 212p/kg. Malcolm Davies' red

Limmie also achieved 212p/kg for 554kg. Sam Swinnerton topped the black and white section at 170p/kg, with all Holsteins averaging 154p/kg.

One of the most successful sales in Bridgnorth for some time with customers from far and wide to purchase all grades of store sheep.

Store Lambs to £75 averaging £62.60

John Lawley's lambs to £75 and several consignments averaging over £70, notably 120 Suffolks from David Bradley who was awarded first prize by judge Roger Davies selling to £72 and averaging £71, with second prize to Brian Wilkinson realising £71.50. Smaller lambs all £60 plus with only very long term plain sheep under £55, even Hebridean cross at £50.

Ewe lambs sold to £82 from James Binnian for Suffolk x Mules taking first prize and second prize went to a run of New Zealand Suffolk x Mules to £80 generally considering more interest in ewe lambs.

A mixed entry of breeding ewes sold to a near total clearance with Texel yearlings £128, £108 Lleyl yearlings, £99 Suffolk yearlings and £90 small North Country Mules. Older ewes to £83 full mouthed North Country Mules, £90 2yo Texels and £70 aged Suffolks.

The best supported fair for many a year with a market full of genuine store cattle, many off local farms. A super run of 157 bullocks from D Alpe sold to average £1000, with the champion steers from JT Rochelle selling to £1330. There was a very firm level of demand with strong feeding cattle particularly sought after, as were young feeding bulls. Young small heifers looked a little better value but with many of these below 275kg. Very many thanks to Mr Ed Garrett of the NFU for sponsoring the event. Our judge, Mr Gwyn Williams, did a sterling job with lots of bunches to take into account and his results are as follows;
