A small entry with producers getting on with sowing and maize harvest. Those farmers who managed to collect a few beasts together were well rewarded with a tidy trade throughout. Especially on the cattle suitable for retail trade. Our regular buying support will be looking for cattle next week, with orders left short today.

Steers sold to 206p/kg or £1320 in the lump, with only very lean cattle purchased. Butchers heifers sold to 252p/kg with several others in the 230p/kg + 240p/kg. Heavier females sold to £1315.

Bull trade was no worse, with fewer Black & Whites forward but there were a few proper tail end Charlies! Sucklers available, sold to 195p/kg with heavier sucklers passed £1500 on four occasions to £1596 in the lump.

This year's St Luke's fair was very well supported by buyers and vendors alike with the beef trade really struggling, a satisfactory store trade resulted with only 2 blondes failing to find new homes. British blue cross steers from Malcolm Pratt sold to £970 at 25m with Chris Walker selling his 18 month Limousin cross steers to £955 and his heifers to £950, closely followed by Tim Kyte selling 4 Simmental to £910.

STORE SHEEP 1200

Less lambs than recent years for the St Luke's Fair, a reflection of the good growing season and increased numbers of fat lambs sold. Trade very similar to recent sales with the longer term lambs looking very well and sold around £60.

Stronger lambs to £68 – Texels from WJ Rogers & Son and £66 Suffolks from DJ Bradley. Smaller Lleyns at £60, Texels at £62 and Suffolks £58.

A very good entry of ewe lambs sold to a selective trade. Customers willing to pay for quality, selling to £93 for Suffolks and Bradley, £75 – North Country mules from Mike Halford and £80 Lleyns from Julian Kirby.

A very mixed entry of breeding ewes met a very sharp trade. North Country Mules £95, 2YO £87 Zwartbles, £90 yearlings, mules 3 + 4 YO £76, small Suffolk x Texel yearlings £90 and Texel 2YO £94. Dorset ewes running with ram to £82 and Scotch Black face £52.

Breeding ram to £310 - Texel x Beltex yearlings, £215 Charollais yearlings and £220 Blue faced Leicester yearlings.
