Numbers hard to come by again but with some tremendous cattle forward – a credit to all our producers. A firm trade throughout, with finish and meat a priority as usual. Without wishing to repeat the same old tune – more were needed to satisfy buyers' requirements.

A few steers saw a high of 318p/kg with dairy bred cattle to £2099 in the lump.

Heifers were quality generally, selling to 352p/kg on two occasions, with heavy females to £2158.

Some very decent meated bulls penned this morning saw a top of 303p/kg and heavy Herefords to £2206 in the lump.

Four cull cows saw a top of 228p/kg for 766kg Limmie crosses £1746, with 800kg Herefords to 210p/kg.

A tidy Limousin/Blue from Harvey Parkes starred at 318p/kg for 568kg, with a very well presented dairybred Limmie bullock from Sam & Rob Jones sold to 290p/kg for 724kg (£2099.60).

The best heifers were generally a little heavier today hence a top price of 352p/kg for 550kg and 546kg from Evans Curdale and Harvey Parkes respectively. The same clients also sold a heifer each to 350p/kg! A stonking Blonde Limmie from Richard Skellern stacked up well at £2158.12 for 662kg, with Neale Dalton selling their heaviest to £2026.20 for 614kg.

Not quite the power of last week from Dave Jones topped at 303p/kg for 662kg Limmie with his Hereford adding up nicely at £2205.20 for 740kg (298p/kg).
