147 PRIME CATTLE

Some super cattle forward generally met a firm trade with butchers reporting some seasonal buying which has been helped by the colder weather of recent weeks. Producers with very lean sorts has less joy reaching their aspirations with those with well-finished cattle achieving above their horizons!

A very disappointing show of bullocks with shapely but lean cattle to 200p/kg, with heavier dairy crosses to £1267.20. More well-finished bullocks are desperately required.

Some real crackers in the heifer department sold to 247p/kg on two occasions, with many others 240p/kg and upwards. Heavy females to £1348.20.

Bull numbers seem to be drying up at the moment with only 44 forward. A very firm trade with finish and quality more important than age! Limousins sold to 217p/kg, with Friesians to 179p/kg. Well-finished black and whites in strong demand.

9 COWS forward met a dearer trade with three buyers attending. Some well-meated suckler cows from Rob Hartley sold to 134p/kg for 640kg Saler crosses with another to 130p/kg. Simmental crosses to 120p/kg from a “deserving cause”. Buyers will be looking for cows and stock bulls next week without fail.

103 CLEAN CATTLE

11 steers sold to average 166p/kg – Very disappointing entries of bullocks this morning saw Frank Millichamp selling 600kg Blondes to 200p/kg, with handy-weight Limmies from John Rochelle selling to 188p/kg. Angus from John Cantrill hit 187p/kg for 620kg. British Blues crosses from Terry Bebb sold to £1267.20 for 704kg.

92 heifers sold to av. 201p/kg – Roger Jordin and Richard Parkes stole the honours here achieving 247p/kg, with several others from the two homes achieving passed 240p/kg. Tom Howells’ British Blues sold to 144p/kg for 524kg with 522kg to 242p/kg from Glyn Powell. 630kg Blondes from John Cantrill sold to £1348.

44 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 171P/KG

Well-finished bulls from Colin Evans saw his 492kg Limousin to 217p/kg, with 582kg Blondes from Brian Watkins to 214p/kg. 618kg Limmies from Tom Howells sold to 204p/kg, with Charolais to 199p/kg from Robert Hartley.

Black and white bulls were a revelation once again selling to 179p/kg from Ian Moreton.
