A small entry as expected with trade very mixed. Steer trade was above the corresponding deadweight values for this week but there were not enough heifers 520kg and below to satisfy orders, with heavier heifers a more difficult trade.

Steers sold to 208p/kg to £1308 in the lump with handy heifers to 232p/kg, with commercial females more in with the competition as opposed to our normal premium price advantage.

More handy-weight meated bulls under 600kg were needed, as requested by the man in the box-consequently buyers couldn't really get started. Best shop bulls sold to 221p/kg with Friesians to 191p/kg and were a sharp trade unless very plain which reflected the cow trade more closely.


