135 PRIME CATTLE

Similar numbers forward this morning and some great quality sorts to boot! A tremendous trade throughout with an overall average including bulls, overages, non-assured etc. of 219p/kg. The cattle were a real credit to all producers and our thanks for their continued support in these difficult times.

More steers about today with a sprinkling of good types selling to 281p/kg for handyweights or £1681 in the lump for average Limmies.

Best handyweight butchers heifers in short supply and sold to 296p/kg, with plenty of females above 270p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1642.

A sharp trade on all the bulls, with all well meated sorts easily sold but with several customers looking for plainer types. Best Continentals topped at 242p/kg or £1674 in the lump. Black and whites saw another first class do selling to 199p/kg.

Only 2 cows forward sold to an easier trade with thick Limousin cows selling to 122 + 121p/kg respectively. More cows are needed to allow orders to get started!

85 CLEAN CATTLE

28 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 210P/KG

Headliners here came from Andrew Bishop, selling his butchers steer to 281p/kg for 514kg with his second steer selling to 270p/kg for 488kg. 642kg shapey Blondes from Frank Millichamp sold to 261p/kg with Limmies to 253p/kg from Roger Jordin. 32 months Limmies from John Rogers sold to £1680.80 in the lump for 764kg. 828kg Hereford cross steers sold to £1564.92 from James Griffin.

57 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 243P/KG

A great show of heifers saw a top price from the Bishop stable once again with his red Limmie to 296p/kg for 496kg. Second spot went to Mrs 'B' selling her best to 289p/kg for 490kg, closely followed by a superb showing from Richard Parkes selling to a high of 286p/kg for 528kg. The Parkes' also sold 4 others from 270 + 272p/kg, with Mrs 'B' taking 4th place at 275p/kg. Rob Amphlett's 714kg Limousin added up nicely to £1642.20 with Roger Jordin selling to £1598.58.

50 BULLS SOLD TO OV.AV. 199P/KG

As a few of last year's spring bulls reveal themselves a decent entry of bulls penned this morning. Best suckers sold to 242p/kg for 692kg from John Hewitt with another to 235p/kg from the same home. Two shapey Blondes from Dan and Brian Watkins both sold to 233p/kg for 682kg + 610kg. Rob Hartley's useful run sold to 230p/kg for 598kg British Blues.

Neil Beaumont sold his Black and Whites to 199p/kg for a half tonne, with more dairy bulls needed to satisfy demand.

For the first time for many weeks trade has slowed, with export driving the price of meat, the third wave of Covid across Europe has at best reduced confidence. That said, trade remains well in front of last year, averaging a respectable 282p/kg, which would include large numbers of under-finished sheep pushed out to catch the trade.

Best hogs well over 320p/kg to a top of 328p/kg for 41kg from David and Caroline Evans and £151.50 Texels from Richard Morgan.

Customers prepared to pay for fed quality hogs but reluctant to pay what is premium prices for under-finished stock.

Heavier weights remain well sold, with 46kg at 305p/kg from Kevin Scott and the over 50kg's to 262p/kg from Evans (Curdale).

Hogs under 34kg sold to 317p/kg from Tony England generally, with Continentals 290p/kg to just over £3/kg and hill breeds 270p/kg to 285p/kg.

Good show of hogs required next and every week with strong buying support for all weights of hogs.

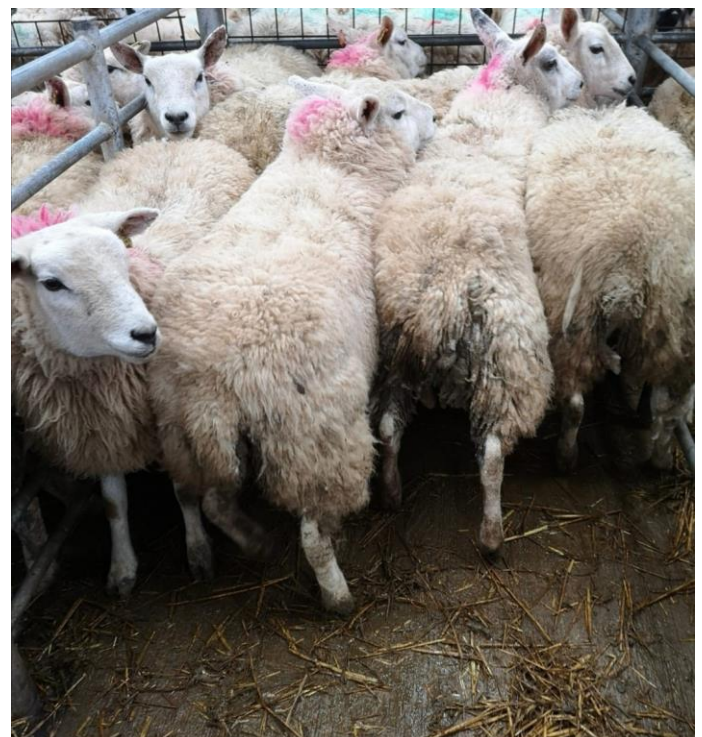
