178 PRIME CATTLE

It was good to see that the upturn in trade continues on from last week. Both the best and second quality saw improved values with clean cattle hard to find once again with more bulls coming forward as last year's single sucklers come fit. More steers but with few best sorts forward and more Holsteins. Blondes sold to 215p/kg or £1389 in the lump.

A tremendous trade on butchers heifers sold to 251p/kg with more selling between 220p/kg and 240p/kg than recent markets.

Second quality clean much dearer when dead than they have been and are beginning to stack up for producers.

Strong bull numbers saw trade at least hold its own with sucklers to 213p/kg, with handy and heavy weights seeing competitive bidding. Bulls sold to £1521 with meated Friesians/Holsteins eagerly sought after to 169p/kg on many occasions.

16 COWS & 8 STOCK BULLS

Trade remains firm here also with all cows penned today Farm Assured, although non FABBL cows would have found plenty of bidders if available. Meaty Blonde cows sold to 138p/kg for 646kg, with 758kg Holsteins to 122p/kg. 34m ultra-plain Holstein bulls to 89p/kg for 652kg.

84 CLEAN CATTLE

24 steers sold to av. 174p/kg – including several Holsteins and cattle over 36 months. Blondes from Frank Millichamp sold to 215p/kg, with Limousins to 213p/kg from Dave Chilton and 208p/kg from Mr England. 34m Longhorns to 170p/kg from Mrs Plant, with 686kg Holsteins to 150p/kg from JV Corfield.

64 heifers sold to average 208p/kg – 508kg Lims from the Bower stable headed the day at 251p/kg, with Richard Parks selling two Lims to 240p/kg. Dave Chilton returned from Espagnol to achieve 234p/kg, 236p/kg, 237p/kg and 239p/kg for most of his run of females. Julian Aston sold to 237p/kg and 234p/kg for his sweet handy-weights, with Rob Hartley and Charlie Sandells selling to 236p/kg and 235p/kg respectively. 600kg Blondes sold to £1350 from the Coppice Farm ponderosa.

90 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 175P/KG

Fewer handy-weight best bulls forward but with some good heavy sucklers forward. Rob Hartley's super run was headed by a 564kg Blonde at 213p/kg with 598kg British Blue at 212p/kg from Ed Green, Too many bulls to mention achieving over 200p/kg but with Todd Harris selling 742kg Lims to £1521.10 at 15m. 22m Lims to £1435.92 at 744kg from David Preece. Dave Cantrill, Rita Corfield & Roger Rowson also sold black and whites to 169p/kg.

Trade in freefall wit retailers experiencing very slow sales and exporters extremely quiet; a combination of the very strong pound and reduced demand for UK lamb on mainland Europe.

On a bad trade, Bridgnorth's trade would look respectable against other auctions, although an average of 164p/kg in June with lambs realising £65 to £75 per head is not good enough to sustain lamb production.

Highlights this week a top price of 193p/kg for 44kg rom Peter Levi and £90.75 from D Norton. Heavier sheep realising no less per kilo than lighter sorts.

Commercial lambs generally realising 160p/kg to 165p/kg with young, tight skinned lambs realising a premium to 189p/kg for 37.5kg.

Dave Ball sadly passed away last week and as bad as the lamb trade was, he would have been very pleased to see his two pens of exceptional Texel lambs realise 190p/kg.

Despite the reduced lamb trade, the ewe trade is holding up well with black ewes to £94 from David Talbot, Charollais £92, Leicesters £90 and Suffolks £89.

As last week, only very fat ewes showing signs of easing with large lean ewes once again order of the day.

Rams to £114 Suffolk and Texel, with Charollais at £110.

Small hills ewes to £51 lean Welsh, £60 Beulah and Wethers £70.
