Some quality, well-meated cattle penned this morning met a similar trade to last Tuesday, with a handful more ordinary sorts mixed in – especially in the bulls. Over 20 cattle sold to 300p/kg or above. More buying support around the ring looking for well-finished heifers.

Steer numbers just into double figures saw a high of 298p/kg with heavies just short of £2000.

Plenty of best heifers sold to a high of 318p/kg with heavier females to £1903 in the lump

A sharp trade on best, heavy bulls saw six selling past £2000 to a high of £2191 or 294p/kg. Leaner bulls perhaps a little harder work in places.

11 STEERS SOLD TO OV AV 270P/KG

Last in from Richard Morgan headed this section at 298p/kg for 606kg Limmie. Mrs B sold her two best Limmie bullocks to 295p/kg for 676kg and 652kg, with very quick Limousins to 287p/kg for 564kg. 706kg Blue Friesians from Sam Jones stacked up nicely at £1997.98.
