With cattle numbers back to a more sustainable level, buyers got stuck in and trade was good. Whether it was quite as dear as last week's "apprentice" managed is debatable. Best cattle were not too plentiful and with some funny goods helping to distort averages in a place or two.

Some quality handy-weight steers penned this morning but mainly lean enough for most tastes sold to 212p/kg. The remainder of our bullock entry was dairy bred, non-assured and/or over-age.

Butchers heifers in strong demand selling to 250p/kg with numerous others above 240p/kg. Heavy heifers to £1313 in the lump.

An improved number of bulls saw trade moving slowly forward, with best handy-weights to 226p/kg. Heavy sucklers sold to above £1300, with Friesian/Holsteins a real trade to 184p/kg.

14 COWS FORWARD met a sharp trade with Hereford x Friesian sucklers to 128p/kg for 638kg, with meated Friesian cows to 124p/kg for 762kg. The fattest of the fat traditional Herefords sold to 85p/kg but may have benefitted from Farm Assurance.

12 steers sold to average 166p/kg – do not be deceived by the averages – there was a real mixed bag in front of the gavel today. Some shapey lean Blondes from Conington Farms sold passed 200p/kg on three occasions to 212p/kg for 524kg. 484kg Limousin crosses to 190p/kg from Richard Ince.

70 heifers sold to av. 203p/kg – A cracking 454kg Limousin from Jan Edwards topped the day at 250p/kg, with 534kg Lims to 246p/kg from IGC Morris. Roger Jordin's runs of red Limmies sold to 245p/kg twice and also to 241p/kg and 240p/kg. Stuart Bebb's Limousin sold to 244p/kg. Steve Davies returned to achieve 241p/kg and we were delighted to see Edward & Julie Green in the market selling British Blues also to 241p/kg.
