71 PRIME CATTLE

Very short of cattle with some buyers looking for numbers and others not requiring so many – a very mixed picture in the industry at present. Bull trade took a backward step without being disastrous, but with clean cattle dearer and in front of expectations. Clean cattle vendors would leave satisfied generally, with deadweight centres pulling values back.

A 'Baker's Dozen' of steers sold well with some very commercial types forward. Continentals sold to 291p/kg or £1857 in the lump.

Six females hit the magic 300p/kg to a high of 316p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to a top of £1792.

Decent bull numbers saw Continentals to a top of 259p/kg or £1824.70 in the lump. Black and Whites saw a decent level of demand to 215p/kg. One very fat Hereford cross cow sold pretty tidily to 138p/kg or £1173 in the lump.

41 CLEAN CATTLE

13 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 231P/KG

Mrs B starred in the bullock section with her sharp 638kg Limmie selling to 291p/kg (£1859) and her handy weight Bazadaise selling to 280p/kg. It was great to see Charlie Sandells in town selling his 582kg Limmie to 275p/kg. Keith Alderson's Herefords stacked up nicely to £1720.50 for 804kg, with Terry Bebb selling his Blue crosses to £1674.60 for 728kg. Overage Longhorns sold to £1519.86 for 694kg from Mr Williams.

28 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 277P/KG

A superb run from Evans (Curdale) started at 316p/kg for 526kg, with six averaging 295p/kg. Neil Perkins sold his penultimate two to 307p/kg and 301p/kg, both around 500kg, with Richard Parkes selling his run to 298p/kg for 528kg. Heavy Lim/Blues sold to £1792.20 for 618kg from that 'deserving cause'.

30 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 223P/KG

Two belting Limousins from the Kirton family headed this department at 257p/kg or £1824.70 in the total. A deserving cause sold to 249p/kg with Rob Hartley and Andrew Preece hitting 246p/kg with Glyn Powell selling to 247p/kg.

Heavy lambs remain dear with 46kg from Andrew Preece at 264p/kg and 62kg lambs from Roger Burgoyne at £145.08 a head. A consignment of 50 lambs from Tony Davies averaging £130.50. Lambs under 40kg a much-improved trade, with 39.5kg at 259p/kg and 35kg to 249p/kg.

price resistance. Better ewes to £180 for Continental ewes from Peter White, Suffolk ewes generally lacking power to £145 and North Country Mules around £100. Large, lean ewes easily sold with Mules £85 and Suffolk £100. 'Nothing' ewes were harder to sell, especially when lean.
