96 PRIME CATTLE

Trade appears to be struggling at the moment, with a real 'back end' feel to it. Best clean cattle easiest placed and sold to a dear trade if they ticked all the boxes. Despite the lower demand, we had a ring full of buyers in attendance with only some of the Holstein bulls and the cull cows suffering a demise.

A fair steer section saw best shapes to 222p/kg with heavies to £1365.

Butchers heifers were the order of the day once again selling to 249p/kg, with eleven others 240p/kg or above. Heavy heifers to £1327.36.

Bull trade much harder work especially on the black and whites and saw Continentals selling to 212p/kg and heavies just short of £1400. Friesians sold to 162p/kg.

8 COWS FORWARD sold to a high of 139p/kg for a meadow fed Blonde at 756kg. Steaking Limousins sold to 104p/kg. A disappointing trade for the producers.

56 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 7 Steers sold to ov.av. 201p/kg – Rita Corfield-McCowan and family topped here with their 536kg British Blue at 222p/kg, with two Limousins from Phil Roberts selling to 208p/kg for 586kg and 558kg respectively. Millichamp Bros sold 604kg Blondes to 204p/kg with 704kg to £1365.76.

Only 49 Heifers sold to ov.av. 210p/kg – A cracking bunch from Roger Jordin sold to a high of 249p/kg with other Lims to 247p/kg. The Jordins also sold 544kg to £1327.36 (244p/kg). Dan Williams headed in from the west selling to 245p/kg for handy-weight Charolais, with Richard Parkes, Dave Digwood and Stuart Bebb all achieving 240p/kg or above.

40 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 167P/KG

A tricky day in the bulls but with the best end holding up well. 628kg Limousins topped at 212p/kg from Roger Tomley, with 588kg Lims to 209p/kg for Bill Yeomans. Blondes from Charlie Lloyd sold to 204p/kg at 536kg. Blondes at 710kg added up nicely from Glyn Powell & Co at £1398.70.

Black and whites sold to 162p/kg from Charlie Lloyd, with Ed Green and Roger Rowson selling to 160p/kg.

This year's St Luke's Fair attracted a larger entry of store lambs however, a higher proportion of smaller lambs than other years.

First prize was presented to Howard Mottershead whose Suffolk lambs realised £67. Texels from WJ Rogers at £66.50 and Texel x Mules from John Lawley at £65.

Smaller but very nice Lleyl lambs from Jules Kirby at £63.50, Charollais £60 and Suffolks £59.50.

Plenty of smaller, mini and micro lambs. £37 for Texel x Scotch Blackface to £46 for Suffolks.

Ewe lambs sold to £75 for North Country Mules from Mike Halford and £70 for first prize Suffolk x Mules from Mark Gatehouse. Generally customers very selective and only prepared to buy ewe lambs that would make nice ewes, otherwise no more than store lamb price.

A smaller number of breeding ewes at £94 Zwartble yearlings, £92 Lleyl 2 year olds and £91 Mule yearlings.

Rams to £325, £320, £300, £280, £270 for Texel yearlings and £240 Charollais yearlings.
