Bulls a little dearer with better bulls to 266p/kg and £1729. With black and white bulls well sold to 213p/kg and plainer bulls short in number, but sought after with customers for plainer bulls unable to fulfil their orders.

Only heavy weight steers forward with steers averaging £1650 to £1737, for a 524kg Limmie from Dave Bradley and 642kg Limmie at 243p/kg.

## 52 HEIFERS SOLD TO AVERAGE 277P/KG

The average up 27p/kg more a reflection on quality than trade, although trade would be brisk, quality was superb. Curdale topped the scale with 528kg Limmie at 319p/kg just shading 318p/kg achieved by Evan Watkin from over the border.

A combination of Sue Evans and a novice auctioneer resulted in her entry of 10 cattle averaging 301p/kg.
