113 PRIME CATTLE

Too few cattle to satisfy demand – an improved trade all through. A full buying contingent present with two buyers leaving empty-handed and everybody short of beasts. Second quality cattle saw a marked improvement, with best cattle perhaps 5p/kg dearer.

A sprinkling of steers forward with some decent sorts amongst them. Continentals sold to 224p/kg, with heavies to £1310.

Butchers heifers sold to 249p/kg, with several others passed 240p/kg. Some of the more commercial heifers 10p/kg plus more money.

Bull numbers tight once again and with the largest majority Holsteins. Trade was firm here also but perhaps without the lift on the clean department. Suckler bulls sold to 205p/kg with Holsteins to 175p/kg.

15 COWS FORWARD saw an improved trade once again with limited quality penned. Meated Limousins sold to 146p/kg and 149p/kg, with plain steakers to 95p/kg for Holsteins. Non-assured cows dearer to 116p/kg for Simmentals.

75 CLEAN CATTLE

18 steers sold to average 193p/kg – A 550kg Limousin with shape from John Cantrill took the top spot here at 224p/kg with 538kg British Blues to 219p/kg from John Gore. Alistair Beedles sold 578kg Limousin to 214p/kg. Blondes from Rita Corfield sold to £1309.44 for 682kg.

57 heifers sold to av. 210p/kg – “Tucked up” Blondes took the headlines at 249p/kg, 247p/kg and 243p/kg for a “deserving cause”, with Limmies from Richard Parkes selling to 247p/kg and 246p/kg. Other Lims sold to 245p/kg from Roger Jordin.

John Gore’s British Blue crosses sold to 199p/kg, with Charlie Lloyd’s Limmie to 198p/kg. 722kg Limousins from Dave Preece sold to 194p/kg to add up to £1400.68.

A large percentage of our entry was non-farm assured, under-finished and over-fat, with virtually every breed on the breed chart; Badger Face, Welsh, Jacob, Mules and Continentals. If ever proof was needed that markets have customers for all, then today was a prime example.

Best hogs well over 200p/kg to 211p/kg from Ray Gregory and 209p/kg from George Evans with plenty realising 190p/kg to 196p/kg.

An improved trade for 45kg to 50kg sheep, with 46.5kg again from Ray Gregory at 178p/kg.

Over 50kg hogs in demand with a new customer to take heavy hogs with 53kg to 156p/kg and to a top price per head of £117.60 for 84kg at 140p/kg.

Plenty of lighter weights this week to 199p/kg for 32.5kg from Richard Cotham with hill breeds to 171p/kg for 31kg, with prices generally ranging from 155p/kg to 165p/kg depending on quality.

More heavy weight hogs required to meet increased buying support.
