99 PRIME CATTLE

With many markets short of cattle at present and deadweight centres ringing around for stock we had a decent show of cattle – not quite meeting that magic `100' figure. Many more cattle on the heavier side, which sold like hot cakes, especially if well-finished. Our overall market average of 266.25p/kg was not to be sniffed at, with heifers to £2047, steers to £1929 and bulls to £1800.

Only a small packet of steers saw best shapes to 310p/kg, with heavy bullocks to £1929.44.

A super show of heifers but with fewer handyweights of 500kg types penned. Butchers' sorts sold to 327p/kg for 546kg with eleven 300p/kg or above. Heavy females sailed to £2046.72.

Improved bull numbers topped at 272p/kg or £1801 in the lump. Black & White bulls sold to 228p/kg. Plenty of competition for all types and shapes of bulls as long as they are not too lean.

Only one cow forward, met a sharp trade with a Holstein cross Angus cow to 166p/kg for 754kg (£1251.64).

Starring Limmie Bullocks from the Parkes stable topped at 310p/kg for 548kg with 570kg British Blues to 270p/kg from the Whiteman Bros, 778kg Blondes from Millichamp Bros sold nicely to £1929.44 in the lump.

The top four prices also went to the Parkes family selling 546kg Lims to 327p/kg with others to 323p/kg, 322p/kg and 318p/kg. A great run of heavy Limousins from Evans Curdale excelled at 315p/kg for 572kg Limmies, with 656kg to 312p/kg or £2046.72 in the lump. 536kg Limmies to 311p/kg from Martin Pain.

39 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 218P/KG

John Hewitt was top dog in this section selling his 638kg Limousin to 272kg, with his 672kg to 268p/kg (£1800.96). 598kg Lim crosses from Charlie Lloyd sold well to 250p/kg.

A sharp trade on Black & Whites saw 576kg selling to 228p/kg again from Mr Lloyd with 522kg to 224p/kg from James Woolrich and 706kg Holsteins to £1517.90 from David Preece.

On a week when most markets are reporting reduced entries, Bridgnorth had a full yard of hoggs, with several runs of fed hoggs proving very easy to sell. Handier weights at 250p/kg to a top of 280p/kg for Texel hoggs from Rob Jones, The Lowe Farm, heavier hoggs also showing real improvement to £163.20 from Richard Morgan.

The overall average would have looked far better were it not for the large numbers of Welsh-sired hoggs. 30kg to 35kg Welsh around 210p/kg, with hoggs around 40kg 225p/kg to 230p/kg.

Generally lighter hoggs keenly sought after with shapey 34.5kg sorts from Tom Richardson at 255p/kg.

Heavy hoggs just shy of 250p/kg for well finished Suffolk x Mules grossing £235 from Pete Morris.
