149 PRIME CATTLE

With hay making in full flow, there were a few less cattle forward today with nearly half as many bulls penned. A very mixed sample with several vendors 'tidying up' shed cattle met a generally improved trade, producing a satisfactory overall average of 172p/kg.

Best bullocks seem to have disappeared in recent weeks with the best available selling to 205p/kg of £1296 in the lump. Steers sold in front of dead weight quotes for this week.

A sharp butchers heifer trade in line with recent sales, sold to 232p/kg with many passed 220p/kg. There were plenty of small cattle without meat or shape penned today.

Bull trade to a step forward having got stuck in reverse last week. Shop bulls sold to 194p/kg with heavies to £1245. A very plain sample of Holsteins with store black and whites 70-90p/kg included in the average.

9 COWS & 4 STEERS SOLD TO AV. 134P/KG

Once again, the cows are easiest sold with Blonde meat cows selling to 160p/kg on two occasions, with Angus steers over 45 months to 156p/kg for 670kg, Highland cows to 100p/kg.

97 CLEAN CATTLE

21 steers sold to average 168p/kg. British Blues from LH Wardle sold to head this section at 205p/kg for 598kg. 574kg Limousin crosses from John Johnston sold to 193p/kg, with 686kg Charolais to 189p/kg from the same stable. Herefords perhaps a little rich to 164p/kg for 542kg from Chris Walker.

76 heifers sold to average 187p/kg. Steve Perkins' handy 460kg Limousin topped the day at 232p/kg, with Richard Parkes' run to 229p/kg and 227p/kg. Dave Chilton's nice run sold to 227p/kg and 24p/kg both around the ½ tonne mark. 552kg Limousins sold to 225p/kg from Thomas' Little London. Miss Kirkham's big day out with 4 came to a successful conclusion with 484kg Lims selling to 223p/kg.

52 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 155P/KG

30 Holsteins etc. were penned this morning and are included in the average. Blondes 508kg topped the bull beef at 194p/kg from Dan & Brian Watkins, with Richard Parkes closely in tow at 188p/kg for his Limousin cross. 626kg Limos from Andrew Preece sold to 186p/kg with 614kg to 184p/kg from Ed Green. Holsteins sold to 160p/kg from Graham Johnson.
