Steer numbers in double figures this morning with best types selling to 216p/kg or £1438.56 in the lump.

A good go on the butchers heifers with shapey heifers to 253 + 252p/kg, with others in the 240p/kg. Buyers struggled to gather heifers 520kg and below together.

No bite in the bull department with shop bulls selling to 205p/kg. Black and white sold to 166p/kg for Kiwi crosses.
