#### **137 PRIME CATTLE**

More numbers forward this morning, although bull numbers still remain tight. There were definitely more middle-of-the-road cattle penned this morning, which depleted averages, although trade was easier generally, with butchers reporting a slower demand as the Christmas credit card bills hit the doormats! Well-finished cattle with a bit of weight and shape are still adding up well.

A better show of steers with the best shapes and handyish weights selling to 269p/kg or £1659.96. Plenty of steers were lean enough today.

Butchers' heifers sold to 303p/kg with two others in the 290 pence bracket. Heavier females sold to £1774 and £1768 in the lump.

Decent bull numbers but still too few for the regular men. Trade held pretty firm here with suckler bulls selling to 244p/kg. Heavy suckler bulls sold just below £1700. Some tidy Friesian Holsteins in a spot or two to a high of 209p/kg.

Six cows forward sold to a high of 167p/kg for 622kg, Limousins (see photograph) with other Limousins to 157p/kg for 748kg and 144p/kg for 804kg.

Cow demand is good at present.
