## Prime Cattle (Red)

### 180 PRIME CATTLE

A very difficult trade once again with even the butcher retailers complaining about the lack of trade over their counters. As previously reported in recent sales, cattle that did not tick all the boxes for the buyers are awkward to place. Cattle that are too fat are not really required at the moment as they involve extra costs with trimming and cost is an issue even on a good trade!

The general quality of clean cattle was in front of last week but it was unusual to sell a beast above 220p/kg. Hereford cross Limousin steers sold to 208p/kg, with heavy steers to £1428.84. Butchers heifers sold to 248p/kg for 508kg British Blues with strong females to £1446.40.

Bull trade was no worse with plenty of awkward brethren forward. It was interesting how several producers having reverted to selling direct were back in town with their 16m plus aged bulls! Thanks lads. Handy weight Blondes sold to 218p/kg at 21m with Limmies to 217p/kg at 23m. Friesian Holsteins sold to 157p/kg. There was increased buying support for bulls today.

### 36 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO OV. AV. 119P/KG

A better number forward with trade holding its own generally. There were some better sorts about today with Blonde cows selling to 170p/kg from Roy Kinnish, with 902kg Blonde to 163p/kg also from Manor Farm. Ed Riley's young Limmie sold to 151p/kg, with 814kg Lims to 146p/kg from Neil Perkins. Meat Friesians were thinner on the ground and sold to 112p/kg from Henry Yates. Plain cows saw a better trade and sold around the 80p/kg mark. Blonde stock bulls sold to 119p/kg for 1076kg for DJM Farming.

### 126 CLEAN CATTLE

#### 32 steers sold to average 175p/kg

Both John Cantrill and Peter Raybould sold to 208p/kg for 582kg and 628kg respectively, with 642kg Lims to 205p/kg from Gerald Kincaid. Heavy Limousins from Alastair Beedles sold to £1428.84 for 756kg. There were plenty of plain shapeless sorts forward along with some over thirty month cattle.

#### 96 heifers sold to average 187p/kg

508kg British Blues from Richard Parkes stole the show at 248p/kg, with two others to 229p/kg all from New House Farm. 514kg Lims from Steve Perkins changed hands at 239p/kg, with 640kg Charolais x Lims to 226p/kg for a 'very deserving cause'. Numerous others sold above 200p/kg, with plenty of females looking low per kilo but difficult to sell.

## 52 YOUNG BULLS SOLD OV AV. 152P/KG

Our entry included 30 Holsteins, 1 over thirty monther and only 19 under 16 months of age. Forest Vale Growers topped this section at 218p/kg with their Blonde 552kg at 21m. Mr Williams sold his 518kg Limousin to 217p/kg at 23m. British Blue crosses from Bob Beaman sold to 211p/kg at 16½ months and 714kg (£1506.54). Mary Beaumont sold her well-fleshed black and whites to 157p/kg for 530kg.

A top price this week of 231p/kg for 50 kg Texels from Rob Grinall grossing £115.50 and all heavy sheep averaging just shy of £90. Clean lambs the order of the day with belly clipped sheep selling to a noticeable premium with export spec 193p/kg to 210p/kg. Light weights averaging 182p/kg to 194p/kg for 33 kg Texels with hill lambs to 185p/kg.

## STORE REPORT – 21.02.14

### 202 Store Cattle

More cattle forward than catalogued and a good turnout of purchasers. Trade, although brisk, required work to maintain recent levels. Heavier older sorts attracting careful bidding and more long term younger cattle selling themselves.

Guy Needham's run of Angus and Blondes sold to £950 for 12m Angus steers and £925 for 12m Blonde steers. 7m Simmental steers sold to 228p/kg and British Blue steers to 220p/kg.

Young Continental bulls selling well to 244p/kg. 9m Limousins from Frank Breakwell and £845 for 8m Limousins from Glyn Powell. Older black and white bulls a different story selling under £1 per kilo with 17m to £440.

Heifers sold over £1000 to £1050. 480kg Limousin with the highlight of the sale a 6m Blonde at £800. 9m Charolais weighing 340kg to 222p/kg and 23m Limousins 480kg at 220p/kg. Three in-calf cows due to Simmentals in spring sold to £890.
