207 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward met a lack lustre trade once again with demand lacking at the retail end. Although there were some well-finished quality sorts forward and there were also many cattle that needed selling several weeks ago as they were too heavy and/or fat for the trade. It is difficult to achieve satisfactory prices for in spec cattle let along out of spec. Overall average was 175p/kg.

A large steer entry saw best sorts selling to 212p/kg or £1475 in the lump. Butchers heifers were less money but in line with the current trade and sold to 234p/kg and passed 230p/kg on a few occasions. Commercial quality cattle saw an easier trade. Bull trade was generally fair with best quality types i.e. young and well-finished seeing improved returns. Continentals sold to £1266 as a whole with well-finished black and whites to 172p/kg.

8 COWS SOLD TO AV. 109P/KG

Four buyers present for this mediocre entry. Young fit Limousins sold to 160p/kg for 736kg. Steaking Continentals sold to 115p/kg for 656kg Simmentals. Holstein steakings to 105p/kg.

MORE COWS NEEDED PLEASE

149 CLEAN CATTLE

60 steers sold to average 174p/kg. 634kg Blondes sold to 212p/kg from Frank Millichamp, with a super run of red Limousins to 207p/kg (x2) for 614kg and 565kg from Gerald Kincaid. 628kg Piedmontese cross to 206p/kg from Gordon Jones. 794kg Limousins sold to £1476.84 from John Cantrill. Holsteins to 161p/kg from Mr Boden.

89 heifers sold to average 191p/kg. A superb run of six from Richard Parkes saw his best to 234p/kg and 231p/kg for 510kg and 528kg Limousins. 528kg home bred Limousins from Matt Bower sold to 233p/kg, with 536kg and 538kg Blues and Lims to 230p/kg and 229p/kg from Neil Perkins at lots 1 and 2. Tucked up Blondes from Rob Hartley sold to 229p/kg at 432kg, with 488kg Lims to 227p/kg from Ed Roberts. 664kg Limousins sold to £1328 from Dave Froggatt.

58 BULLS SOLD OV AV. 153P/KG

Our entry included 49 Holsteins and Friesians etc. Handy weight Limousins at 526kg sold to 213p/kg from Henry Yates, with 556kg Blondes to 212p/kg from Bill Yeomans. Brian Watkins sold to 211p/kg at 582kg, with his 612kg model to 207p/kg. Friesians sold to 172p/kg from Mary Beaumont at 568kg, with a similar weight to 170p/kg from Middleton Scriven. Plainer brethren met an easier trade.

Trade as nationally a little easier than last week however no disgrace, averaging 215p/kg to 240p/kg and £120 per head.

Handy weights keenly sought after with plenty of hogs 225p/kg plus and the very best at 240p/kg twice both from Walter Link for 40kg and 43kg Texels, with his 48kg at 233p/kg or £113. Heavy sheep over £2/kg apart from 55kg plus to 219p/kg for 49.5kg and 205p/kg for 53kg.

As the season unfolds, quality varies with finished hogs realising a real premium over under-finished pens.

Spring lambs dearer this week to 264p/kg for 33kg averaging 259p/kg. More lambs could be sold every week.
