#### **90 PRIME CATTLE**

A few less cattle forward with bulls in short supply once again. Trade continues to hold up well with commercial wholesale types dearer than last week. Once again we saw beasts selling above £2000 in the steers, heifers and bull departments.

Only a sprinkling of steers today sold to 290p/kg for a 33 month Continental, with heavier sorts to £2030 in the lump.

Butchers heifers topped at 340p/kg for handy weights with 19 heifers 300p/kg or above. Heavy females topped at £2050 in the lump.

Another good day in the bull section with Continentals topping at 280p/kg with heavy bulls to £2026. Holstein bulls continue to look the dearest sold, stopping at a high of 236p/kg.

2 cull cows and 1 stock bull met tremendous demand with a 6 year old Blue cross selling to 205p/kg for 680kg with non-assured Charolais crosses stacking up well at £1407.90 for 722kg. British White stock bulls sold to 169p/kg for 852kg.

Distance traveller, Mr Willian had a smile on his face going home with £2049.80 for his 740kg Charolais cross with Georgie Delves selling her heaviest Limousin cross to £2031.36.

A small show but with a few tidy sorts penned, saw Dan & Sam Rodenhurst selling to 280p/kg for 622kg with two others to 270p/kg. # ANIMAL HEALTH AND WELFARE – \* NOW OPEN UNTIL MIDDAY ON THURSDAY 15<sup>th</sup> JUNE\*

The **Animal Health and Welfare** theme, which is now open, includes items such as:- mobile or fixed cattle handling systems, cattle crushes, head scoops, mobile or fixed sheep handling systems, weigh bars, electric fencing and ventilation fans.





The grants are for a minimum of £1,000 and maximum of £25,000 per theme, and are based on set grant amounts for each item. The grant element is usually around 40% of the item's cost, however if the price of the item you purchase results in the grant payment making up a lesser or greater percentage, this will not affect the amount of grant paid, so long as the requirements below are still met.

These requirements include all equipment which is purchased to meet the minimum specifications set out within the option guidance, to be brand new (ex-demo or second hand is not allowed) and purchased through a supplier or manufacturer. All items must also be paid for in full (part exchange is not allowed) and no items must be purchased before a grant funding agreement is offered, although it is possible to secure items with a refundable deposit if you are concerned about supply issues.

The application process is competitive with each item given a score, and applications with the highest average scores then being offered agreements.
