A few more cattle forward met a two tier trade, with bulls really suffering at the moment whereas clean beasts sold to a fair trade throughout with best quality selling well above the deadweight equivalent. You would hope trade has bottomed out but there is still talk of plenty of Irish beef floating around, with Brexit and demand from China the only potential light in the tunnel.

Some good steers forward saw the cream selling to 214p/kg or to just short of £1400 on several occasions.

Butchers heifers saw the normal demand topping at 250p/kg with heavy heifers selling to £1315 in the lump. Second quality clean with nowhere to go found new homes at reduced rates. The housewife should be benefitting from cheaper beef on the

The housewife should be benefitting from cheaper beef on the shelves, with bulls meeting a very poor trade at the moment. Three best bulls struggled over 200p/kg to a high of 208p/kg, with Black and Whites selling to 152p/kg.
