Fewer cattle forward, with rain threatened for Wednesday and the combines starting up again, Some useful sorts entered along with several also rans. Welsh orders were missing as they had all "gone to the show", but trade was unaffected with many cattle over 400p/kg dead-weight, especially heifers.

A sprinkling of steers saw the best selling to 229p/kg or £1465.20 in the lump. Several over-weight bullocks forward. Butchers heifers sold to a flying trade to a high of 249p/kg with best shapes not quite as plentiful as last week. Breaking heifers very dear once again and more of these are needed each week. More black and white bulls forward with bull trade holding firm. Best Limousins sold to 216p/kg at 18 months, with Friesian bulls to 180p/kg.

**ONLY 1 COW FORWARD** saw 612kg Brown Swiss cow selling to 102p/kg.
