A smaller show of cattle with trade dictating that less are required at present. Trade possibly a little firmer but not dear enough to get dear stores out of trouble! Once again producers put some first class finished cattle in front of our buyers and should be congratulated.

Less steers saw a top of 280p/kg for well meated Simmentals with no absolute stunners penned. Heavy steers sold to £1753 in the lump.

13 heifers sold at or above 300p/kg today to a high of 323p/kg. Heavy females sold to £2020.

A lack lustre bull trade with manufacturing cattle seeing the brunt of price reductions. Best quality sucklers sold to 274p/kg or £1830 in the lump. Holsteins were pretty shapeless today and sold to a high of 188p/kg.

Two cows forward saw the same fate as the bulls with non-assured cows to 148p/kg for Limmies at 766kg (£1134)

Lambs averaged 260p/kg with better lambs, as recent weeks, keenly sought after to 291p/kg regardless of weight from Nigel Fieldhouse and £146 for 57kg lambs from Burwarton Farms.

The lamb trade remains constant, although values may change customers required meat. Finished lambs are easily sold whereas under finished lean lambs are difficult to sell.

Weight remains no problem with several of the higher prices per kilo for lambs weighing over 46kg. However, with some of the lighter lambs which lacked finish it would have paid to get them a little heavier or better finished.
