176 PRIME CATTLE

A few more cattle forward with 20+ more bulls forward than last week. Trade a little easier on commercial cattle with best clean cattle holding values more easily. Our overall market average of 185p/kg included plenty of Holsteins and runs of cattle over 36 months of age.

Steer numbers were low and included 10 out of 16 that were over 36 months, Best quality, well-finished bullocks were almost non-existent but sold to 224p/kg with heavy commercials to £1318.

Butchers heifers were "on fire" again even with several butchers not wanting cattle today. Although no heifers made 250p/kg, there were a lot in the 240 pence's, with stronger heifers to £1365. There were more common goods penned this morning.

With the bull section very busy, buyers filled awaiting orders more easily. Best bulls met a decent trade unless old and heavy, selling to 214p/kg with heavy suckler bulls to £1424. The black and white entry were generally meated and topped at 174p/kg for Friesians.

12 COWS SOLD TO AV. 112P/KG

A small entry but some good fleshed cows forward. Guy Needham sold Shorthorn crosses to 131p/kg for 700kg with Angus cows to £1167.36 from the same stable. No best dairy cows forward but sold to 99p/kg for 840kg from Mr Everett.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS NEEDED

94 CLEAN CATTLE

18 steers sold to av. 165p/kg – 580kg Limousin crosses easily topped this section for Charlie Sandells at 224p/kg, with his second to 185p/kg for 596kg. Phil Clarke sold British Blues to £1317.44 for 736kg. 40 month Angus steers sold to 160p/kg from Mr Sellman. Ultra-plain Holsteins to 126p/kg were in the averages.

76 heifers sold to av. 202p/kg – A belting run of Continentals from Richard Parkes sold to 249p/kg x 2, with others from 241p/kg to 248p/kg from the same stable. 474kg Blondes from IGC Morris also sold to 249p/kg, with 514kg Limmies to 247p/kg from Roger Jordin. 604kg Angus heifers to £1365 again from the Morris stable.

82 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 176P/KG

With a buyer for the leaner brethren missing, these were less money and the general trade lacking edge. A super run from Roger Tomley frequently sold above 200p/kg, with a Hereford cross selling to 214p/kg for 524kg, with others to 211p/kg (x2). Heavies from Matt Bower sold up to 204p/kg for 698kg Limousins (£1424).

Black and whites sold to 174p/kg on two occasions from Dave Evans, just pipping Henry Yates selling 554kg to 171p/kg (£947.34). Holsteins from Mick Evans sold to 167p/kg for 580kg.
