Trade a little easier this morning, as a recent increase in trade has helped to slow down sales! It would be fair to say that the quality was not quite comparable with last week, with best cattle maintaining values because of this. It was good to see decent numbers again and a few more cows. Please keep them coming- we have good buying support.

A small entry of steers saw plenty of very lean bullocks but with the best to 228p/kg or £1496 in the lump.

Butchers heifers sold to 245p/kg with regular orders for these only partially completed.

Friesian Holsteins with meat easiest to sell with Continentals harder work. Shop bulls sold to 212p/kg, with heavy Continentals to £1420.08 in the lump. Black and whites a revelation as previously mentioned selling to 183p/kg.

19 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Three punters for this section sae trade decent enough although the cows are depreciating a little as they so most beck ends.

Blonde cows 778kg sold to 143p/kg (£1112.54), with more commercial sucklers with meat in the 120 pence's generally. Dairy cows sold to 110p/kg. Limousin stock bulls a cracking trade to 148p/kg for 1004kg.

72 CLEAN CATTLE

11 steers sold to average 178p/kg — A topping Limousins from John Cantrill sold to 228p/kg for 656kg, with non-FABBL bullocks to 209p/kg for 648kg from the Kyte family. 572kg Limousins from Brian & Dave Whiteman sold to 203p/kg.

61 heifers sold to av. 200p/kg — Richard Parkes' usual stamp headed the day at 245p/kg for 498kg, with another to 241p/kg. Charolais from Tony Barker closely followed at 239p/kg, with travelled Limmies from Dan Williams also to 239p/kg. Frank Millichamp's Blondes added up nicely to £1308.72 for 574kg. Second quality clean cattle less money.

55 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 170P/KG

Handy-weights from Brian Watkins sold to 212kg for 492kg, with 608kg to 208p/kg from Roy Kinnish- both Blondes. Two Limmies from Paul Taylor sold to 200p/kg and 202p/kg. Heavy Continentals to £1420.18 from David Preece at 732kg.


A storming Holstein trade with Colin Evans selling to 183p/kg for 522kg, with loads of black and whites well in the 160 pence's from numerous vendors.
