#### **80 PRIME CATTLE**

Similar numbers to last week saw trends at least as sharp as the previous week. Again a shortage of bulls and with several producers emptying bull yards today we look set to lower bull numbers in weeks to come.

Disappointing numbers of steers sold to a level trade to a high of 285p/kg for handyweights, with heavier native breeds £1741 in the lump.

Six heifers sold above the 300p/kg magic number to a high of 330p/kg. Heavy females topped at £1823 in the lump.

A small compliment of mainly continental bulls sold to a high of 270p/kg or £1760 in the lump. Buyers were looking for meaty Friesian Holsteins but there was only one of note to buy.

#### **10 CULL COWS AND OTM STEERS**

A decent show numbers-wise with something for everybody. Speckled Park cows sold to 160p/kg for 620kg, with non-assured Limmies to 150p/kg for 744kg. 5½ year old Dexter steers sold to 158p/kg for 554kg.

#### **58 CLEAN CATTLE**

#### 5 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 265P/KG

Shapey 540kg Limmie steers from Richard Parkes topped here at 285p/kg, with other Limousins from John Cantrill selling to 277p/kg. Heavier Angus steers sold to £1740.64 for 688kg from Mrs Burgoyne.

#### 53 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 265P/KG

A useful run from Mrs B stole the honours today, achieving an unlikely 330p/kg for 518kg Limousin, with another grey Limmie to 305p/kg for 520kg. Roger Jordin took second spot at 326p/kg for 512kg, with Richard Parkes in bronze position at 323p/kg for a similar weight. Heavy females from Gaz & Sid Davies stacked up well at £1823.36 for 616kg.

#### 22 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 229P/KG

A stunning 19-month British Blue from Goulburn Farms excelled at 270p/kg for 652kg (£1760.40). Dave Digwood sold his Limousin to 256p/kg at 582kg but with Andrew Preece selling his 520kg shop bull to 264p/kg. Holsteins were almost non-existent today and sold to 201p/kg from Bob Mayer.

A much better entry of lambs to last week, although trade would be harder work with every sector of the meat industry reporting reduced demand.

Butcher's lambs remain sought after with customers keen to buy finished lambs with shape and finish.

Best lambs to 281p/kg (48kg) Texel lambs from Dave and Caroline Evans realising £134.88. Weight seems to be paying with heavier lambs averaging £124 throughout the sale. Export weights a little easier to sell but lambs under 40kg met a selective trade with nationally an oversupply of hill-bred lambs on the market.

Well-sired lambs generally under 200p/kg, trading around £185 to £195.

Another large entry of ewes with heavy meated ewes most sought after, especially those with shape.

Texel ewes to £140 on two occasions, with smaller, leaner Texel type ewes around £120. Suffolk x Mules, meat but not fat sold to £121, with several selling from £110 to £115. Continental ewes attracting considerable interest with shop ewes in demand.

Mules to just shy of £100 and Mashams £80, lean Mules £50 to £60 with only the absolute crackers under £40. Plenty of hill types to £70 for Cheviots, £49 for Swales and improved Welsh £44.

Charollais rams sold to £100.

Trade over recent weeks has been just off the boil. Meated ewes are required, but plainer ewes would pay to feed. In usual circumstances the ewe trade lifts around Christmas, so value could be added over the next month or so.


