150 PRIME CATTLE

A small increase in numbers this morning but a decrease in quality. Trade was on par with last week generally, with averages depreciated by several non-descript types and over thirty month bulls and clean. The overall market average was 187p/kg.

Steer numbers were greatly improved selling to a high of 218p/kg, with heavies to nearly £1400. Best butchers cattle were in short supply and sold to 248p/kg on two occasions. Commercial sorts met firm demand as long as they had got some meat on them.

Reasonable numbers of bulls forward saw the best selling to 211p/kg or just short of £1400. Friesian bulls were in strong demand selling to 183p/kg.

26 COWS SOLD TO AV. 82P/KG

A better sample of cows following last week's debacle but we still had our share of "lean old dollies"!

Mr Radcliffe sold Simmentals to 116p/kg at 608kg, with Richard Hartley's old faithful to 112p/kg for 696kg. Holsteins sold to 103p/kg from Ed Mullard, with Mr Bomford's Herefords to 97p/kg for 572kg. There were many over fat cows forward with farmers prepared to get some weight on their cattle.

98 CLEAN CATTLE

23 steers sold to av. 183p/kg – A run of handy weights from Gordon & Chris Jones sold to 218p/kg for 556kg Limousin with 626kg Limousin selling to 216p/kg from Richard Milner. Another red Limmie from Gerald Kincaid sold to 203p/kg at 648kg. 670kg Limousins sold to £1393.60 once again from the Milner stable, with 746kg Limousin crosses to £1323 from Terry Bebb. Holsteins sold to 160p/kg from Mr Hurst.

65 Heifers sold to average 188p/kg – Roger Jordin hit 248p/kg on two occasions with 528kg and 522kg Limousins, with 492kg and 522kg Limousin to 246p/kg and 245p/kg from Steve Perkins. British Blues sold to 223p/kg from Ed Green. Dave Chilton, Andrew Craig and Roger Tomley all sold to 220p/kg. Hereford crosses to 173p/kg for 494kg from Ed Bunning.

52 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 171P/KG

Matt Bower took the headlines here selling to 211p/kg and 207p/kg for 660kg and 656kg. British Blues sold to 206p/kg from Martin Morris. Herefords sold to 205p/kg from Roger Tomley, with Angus to 204p/kg for Bill Rodenhurst.

Rita Corfield topped the black and white section selling 540kg to 183p/kg. Well-finished black and whites are possibly the easiest to sell at present.
