# BRIDGNORTH LIVESTOCK MARKET WEEKLY REPORT – 26.01.16



#### **163 PRIME CATTLE**

Handier weight, well-finished but lean cattle were sold a marked premium today but with heavier more commercial sorts going the opposite way. More shapeless cattle forward which depleted averages but there was more demand for the right goods.

Generally a good sample of steers although plenty were lean enough. Heavies sold to 218p/kg or to £1438.80 in the lump.

A mixed bag of heifers saw handy-weight butchers cattle 2-5p/kg more money. The cream sold to 247p/kg, with more over 240p/kg than recent weeks. Heavy females to £1318.50.

Best bulls, especially 600kg or less, met a flying trade with Holsteins a disappointing sample generally. Continentals sold to 226p/kg and black and whites to 162p/kg.

#### **ONLY 12 COWS**

Only 12 cows sold to a dearer trade, with either decent meat cows or boners forward. Best Blonde cows 784kg sold to 157p/kg (£1230.88) with British Blue cows to 130p/kg. Holstein plain steaking cows to 90p/kg.

#### **110 CLEAN CATTLE**

**29 steers sold to av. 185p/kg** – A tremendous 660kg Blonde cross from Frank Millichamp topped the section at 218p/kg (£1438) with handy-weight British Blues from Phil Roberts to 210p/kg. A nice run of spikey Continentals from the Kincaid stable sold to 204p/kg with Martin Faulconbridge selling Blondes to 196p/kg.

**81 heifers sold to av. 196p/kg** – Roger Jordin stole the honours here with his 526kg Limmie selling to 247p/kg. Richard Parkes' normal quality sold to 246p/kg for 468kg, with Richard Morgan hitting 243p/kg for his 498kg British Blue.

#### 53 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 156P/KG

More well-finished young bulls would have sold today with plenty of competition around the ring. Very few suckler bulls penned with the best from IGC Morris selling from 210p/kg to 226p/kg. Steve Howells sold Blondes to 210p/kg for 590kg.

Small, lean Holsteins, some with age helped to deplete averages but met a realistic trade. Colin Evans topped this department at 162p/kg for 500kg. Robin & Chris Maydew sold Friesians to £1063.04.
