Similar numbers to last week, met a decent trade when you consider the large abattoirs took money out of the cattle for this week. Best heifers were not guite the flier of last Tuesday, but with commercial cattle easier to sell.

Only a handful of steers penned saw a high of 310p/kg or £1918 in the lump.

Heifers topped at 336p/kg with numerous past 300p/kg to £2071 as a body.

Some tidy bulls in a place or two headlined at 306p/kg or to £1897 as a whole. Black & white bulls sold to 235p/kg.

More numbers of cows and stock bulls which were guite often on the plainer end. Limousin cross cows sold to 179p/kg for 578kg, with 584kg Angus cross to 158p/kg. Non-assured Simmental cross cows sold to £1093 in the lump. Clean Limousin stock bulls sold to £948 for 790kg.

Useful Limmies from 'Mrs B' topped here at 310p/kg for 594kg closely followed by a red Lim from Marcus Whitehouse at 306p/kg for the same weight. Chris Jones' 680kg Limousin added up well at £1917.60 with 720kg British Blue cross to £1908 from Brian Williams. 172p/kg 'Specials' included in the average!

### 45 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV AV 286P/KG

It was great to see the Edwards family back again and topping the Limousins list at 336p/kg for 546kg with the 668kg Limmie stacking up at £2070.80 (310p/kg). A meaty run from Harvey Parkes sold to 330p/kg with Tony Barker selling a sweet black Limousin to 328p/kg for 534kg. 18 heifers sold to 308p/kg or more today.

A cracking 580kg Limousin from the Dalton stable headed here at 306p/kg or £1774.80 with Bill Yeomans selling to 298p/kg for 588kg. Heavier Limousins from Ben Rochelle at 290p/kg for 654kg to realise £1896.60.


