132 PRIME CATTLE – Overall average 169p/kg (last week 165p/kg)

Hopefully we have seen the worst of the trade as an improved market can be reported today. Best cattle probably 5p/kg dearer generally, more commercial cattle still met a difficult trade but dead-weight centres held their prices for Monday morning, as cattle coming forward start to tighten up. Less number forward, probably discouraged by last week's prices but our advice is to keep drawing your cattle as they come ready so they are not too big or fat for what still is a very demanding marketplace.

Many bullocks lacked flesh today and sold to 199p/kg or £1310 in the lump.

More punters for butchers heifers saw top quality to 245p/kg, with more handy-weight, shapey heifers needed. Heifers to £1204 as a whole.

A similar bull trade but easier sold generally. Handy-weight sucklers sold to 203p/kg, with heavier bulls to £1422.08. Holstein bulls to 152p/kg.

17 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS

Another dearer trade here, with strong demand for a cheap mature product. Young blue cross cows sold to 141p/kg for 568kg, with 820kg slip Holsteins to 128p/kg. Meat black and white cows to 117p/kg. Steaking cows to 108p/kg. Blonde stock bulls to 105p/kg for 982kg, with 1280kg Holstein bulls to 84p/kg.

Ray Bason's three handy-weights hit 229p/kg, with Charlie Sandells achieving the same. We wish all the butchers and wholesalers a busy trade over the Bank Holiday weekend.

Lambs this week to 239p/kg for Texel lambs from Luke Price and £100.20 for 43kg from Peter Kirton. Quality extremely good with several runs of very tight skinned lambs on offer.

Lighter lambs easier to sell with 35kg around 230p/kg to 235p/kg, although a number of lambs well over 43.kg which realised around £93.
