A mixed trade today with some very good cattle forward, along with some very lean sorts. There was a small sprinkling of grass heifers today but most of these had seen the 'corn bag'. More steers forward but many of these were too lean for the customers – a fair trade resulted even so.

Charolais steers sold to a high of 216p/kg, with a distinct lack of best fed bullocks about at the moment. Heavy steers to £1344 in the lump.

Best butchers heifers were no more money selling to 245p/kg, but with more commercial heifers seeing improved returns. Heavy females sold to £1395 in the lump.

A busy bull section with plenty of weight about with handier weight, well-finished types, whether dairy bred or suckler bred, the order of the day. Best sucklers sold to 217p/kg. Heavy bulls met an easier trade to just short of £1400.

6 COWS & 2 STOCK BULLS

A very tidy trade on the cows saw Blonde cows to 169p/kg and 156p/kg or £1360 as a whole. Boning cows with wet bags to 74p/kg. Stock bulls were on the lean-side today and sold to 99p/kg.

73 CLEAN CATTLE

18 steers sold to av. 181p/kg – Most steers required more finishing today but the best meat bullocks saw improved returns. John Johnston's run sold to 216p/kg for 618kg. 550kg Limousins from Brian Whiteman sold to 193p/kg. Friesians to 154p/kg from Robin & Chris Maydew.

55 heifers sold to av. 204p/kg – Matt Bower stole the show this week selling to 245p/kg for 452kg Limousin, with a handy 402kg Limmie to 240p/kg from Jan Edwards. Other Limmies from Dave Thomas took third spot at 237p/kg. Second string cattle with flesh saw a good trade.

60 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 163P/KG

Bull trade remains fickle with bulls under 600kg with finish able to hold values. Shop Limousin bulls from Mrs Edwards sold to 217p/kg, with 504kg to 205p/kg from John Gore and to 200p/kg from Andrew Preece and Steve Perkins. Holsteins sold to 156p/kg from Richard Hartley and to 154p/kg from Ted Jackson.

Generally heavy lambs selling very well, notably 54.5kg at 195p/kg or £106.30. More conventional weights to 208p/kg for 39kg Texel x lambs from Henry Yates. Lighter weights to 191p/kg for 33.5kg from Gerald Carter. With increased buying support, more lambs would easily sell every week.
