Cattle numbers continue to be tight and trade similar to last week, although quality would be mixed. Even so, a very respectable overall average of 247p/kg. More cattle required every week with customers in attendance every week for 100 plus clean cattle.

Steers to a top of 271p/kg with heavy steers to £1690.

Nine heifers over 300p/kg to a high of 320p/kg and handyweight heifers to £1690.

Bulls to a similar trade on last week, with numbers very tight. Quality bulls to 270p/kg and heavy bulls just shy of £2000 at £1963.

14 STEERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 234P/KG

Tony Barker's steers sold to 271p/kg for a 578kg Limousin, then more dairy-bred animals were in the ring weighing around 250p/kg

John Cantrill's Simmentals sold to £1645 for 666kg, with no very heavy steers on offer.

46 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 266P/KG

A tidy run of heifers from Evans Curdale toped at 320p/kg for 528kg Limousins, with six heifers averaging 306p/kg. Limousins from Steve Perkins sold at 311p/kg and the usual quality from Parksey sold to 302p/kg.

25 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 225P/KG

Not many quality suckled bulls on offer. Those that were forward sold well to 270p/kg for a 610kg Limousin from Bill Yeomans and heavy Limmies from Ralph Jones sold to 255p/kg, with bulls over 800kg selling at £1963, also from Ralph Jones. Black and white bulls sold to 225p/kg and £1296.

A reasonable entry of lambs but trade would be easier and for the first time for many months trade was hard work - starting off 240p/kg to 250p/kg and quickly dropping with a sale average of 235p/kg. Trade would be hard work, but not helped by a significant number of lean, under-finished lambs which proved difficult. Finished lambs were well sought after, well over 250p/kg regardless of weight to 272p/kg for 45.5kg Texel lambs from RC Evans Curdale and heavier lambs to £129 for 50kg lambs from Peter Johnson. Lambs under 38kg to 259p/kg from David Talbot for shapey Beltex.

Generally, the heavy lambs were easier sold, but that could have been more a reflection of finish rather than weight.
