121 PRIME CATTLE

A small post-holiday entry met an improved trade with more commercial sorts seeing an upturn in values. Well-finished steers have become particularly scarce and consequently sold 10-15p/kg above recent sales. A full ring of buyers provide strong competition with a resulting overall average of 187p/kg. Steers sold to a high of 229p/kg for 620kg with heavy dairy bred continentals to £1427.40. Butchers heifers met a sharp trade as last week to 235p/kg, with nine others 230p/kg and above. Heavy Charolais heifer to £1373.40.

Bull trade was fair selling to 199p/kg for handy weight sucklers. Heavy Limousins over 16 months sold to £1389.60. No best black and white bulls forward with Holsteins to 168p/kg.

11 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL SOLD TO AV. 93P/KG

No best cows forward but trade remained similar. The average included mainly boning cows with swinging udders!

British Blue cows with flesh sold to 130p/kg for 774kg from Brian Williams, with 640kg Angus to 124p/kg from Harold Pugh. Thick 1158kg Hereford stock bulls sold to 95p/kg.

75 CLEAN CATTLE

14 steers sold to average 187p/kg. 620kg British Blues sold to 229p/kg from James Woolrich, with 516kg Simmentals selling to 224p/kg from Charlie Sandells. Red Limmies from Vincent Evans sold to 219p/kg for 610kg. 732kg Limousins added up to £1427 from Terry Bebb.

61 heifers sold to average 209p/kg. Heifers averaged 5p/kg more than last week's flier! Dave Chilton skipped out of the box selling butchers heifers to 235p/kg, 234p/kg 233p/kg and 232p/kg. 466kg Limousins sold to 233p/kg from Steve Perkins, with Richard Parkes and Peter Raybould also selling above 230p/kg. 654kg Charolais sold to £1373.40 for Glyn Breeze. Second quality clean cattle very dear.

46 YOUNG BULLS OV. AV. 160P/KG

Few suckler bulls forward met a firm trade. Andrew Preece's handy Limousins topped the day at 199p/kg for 470kg, with another to 197p/kg. 720kg Limousins from Mr Breeze sold to 193p/kg or £1373.

Black and whites were headed by Mike Smith's Holstein selling to 168p/kg at 578kg.


