A very good entry of cattle with 99 clean cattle penned. Quality was pretty good throughout the heifers and steers but with fewer better types amongst the bulls. Trade generally a little easier with Christmas spirit not in evidence today. With all that said, cattle would still reflect positively on what is a generally lack lustre trade. Thanks to Will Probert for his sterling effort and his more youthful approach to cattle selling in Bridgnorth! Mark Burgoyne back next week with 20/20 vision! Buyers beware!

Bullock trade was reasonable with some well meated cattle penned. No real monsters so top price was £1284 in the lump with 217p/kg top dollar per kilo.

A very nice sample of heifers saw the cream selling to 255p/kg with 3 others in the high 240 pence's. There was a large discrepancy between the aces and the next best females. Angus heifers sold to £1356.80 in the lump.

Bulls generally lacked quality this morning but shapely Continentals sold to 213p/kg. Black and Whites maintained their values with well finished Friesians selling well to 168p/kg.

One cull cow saw Speckled Parks selling to 85p/kg for 676kg. There is regular buying support for cows each week.
