133 PRIME CATTLE

A superb show of clean cattle with some real quality sorts forward this morning. We were desperately short of bulls this morning and more will be required next week to satisfy regular buyer demand. Trade was very firm throughout with an overall market average including Holsteins and also rans of 226p/kg.

Some meat and shape in the steer department saw the bestselling to 263p/kg or £1620 in the lump. Four other steers sold to 250p/kg or above.

Butchers heifers were a real credit to all the producers this morning with the cream selling to 289p/kg with 5 others 270p/kg or above. Heavy heifers sold to £1600.00.

A great bull trade but some orders struggled to get going. Best Continentals sold to 238p/kg or to £1575 in the lump. Black and White bulls were 'on fire' once again selling to 206p/kg. Many more bulls are needed on this trade!

722kg Limousin cross cows sold to 168p/kg or £1212.96 in the lump. 960kg Beef Shorthorn Stock Bulls sold to 126p/kg.

105 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 19 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 214P/KG

Shapey Limousins from Richard Parkes sold to 263p/kg for 578kg, with Matt and Wendy Bower selling their pair to 257p/kg + 255p/kg. 596kg Limousins from Mr Tolley sold in fourth spot to 252p/kg. James Griffins 740kg Limousin sold to £1620.60 in the lump.

86 HEIFERS SOLD TO OV. AV. 236P/KG

Homebred stars from Andrew Bishop stole the limelight at 289p/kg + 278p/kg for 512kg and 464kg respectively. Both Evans, Curdale and the Parkes' stable sold their best to 271p/kg with two others to 270p/kg from the Parkes's. Mrs 'B' also sold a Limmie to 270p/kg. Handyweight heifers were the order of the day generally but Rob Morris's 640kg Limmie selling well to £1600 exactly!

Homebred Lims from the Rodenhurst brigade sold to 238p/kg for 624kg, with Blues from Mark Jones selling to 235p/kg at 11 months old. 526kg Blondes from Dan Watkins sold to 233p/kg and in third spot 700kg Blondes to £1575 from Glynn Powell. A tremendous go on the Black and Whites, with Colin Evans selling to 206p/kg and Bob Mayor to 205p/kg.
