A disappointing entry of cattle but to be expected with several retail butchers struggling this week with the logistics of processing cattle, with several multi-species abattoirs cutting contract cattle in preference to serving this week's Qurbani trade.

More handyweight 'posh' heifers will be required next week, with these butchers looking to replenish their fridges.

Even with several ringside customers absent, heifers peaked at 341p/kg from Roger Jordin and a very shapey blue heifer from Marcus Whitehouse breaking the 300p/kg and £2000 per head barrier at 302p/kg and £2041.

An entry of mainly dairy-bred steers sold to 296p/kg for one of the few non-dairy steers presented by Roger Jordin and bulk very short in supply, to 248p/kg for the first bull in the ring weighing 614kg from Mike Halford.

John Cantrill's steers sold to 278p/kg for 576kg Simmentals and Roger Jordin's 572kg Limmie sold to 296p/kg. The normal consignment from Dave Preece 29m old weighing 732kg sold to £1844.

Despite the missing faces around the ring the top heifer price of 341p/kg would only fall short of last week's top price by 1p/kg - the highlight of Roger Jordin's entry. Harvey Parkes' heifers sold to 330p/kg for 568kg Limousin and Evans Curdale well-bred 14m old Limmies sold to 329p/kg.

Heavy Belgian Blue heifers of 676kg sold at £2041 from Marcus Whitehouse and just shy of £2000 for Roger Jordin.
