With only plain shaped steers forward, top price was 171p/kg. Heifers sold at 250p/kg on two occasions with many others in the 230p/kg - 240p/kg bracket. Heavy females sold at £1546 in the lump.

Limousin bulls sold to 199p/kg and although nothing made 200p/kg a super trade throughout resulted. Holstein Friesians saw the biggest jump selling to 181p/kg.

Only 3 steers sold to ov.av. 155p/kg – Dairy bred blues sold to 171p/kg for 520kg from Paul Taylor, who now thinks he should have emptied the shed! MORE STEERS NEXT WEEK PLEASE.
