A few more clean cattle forward, with our entry mainly swelled with steers. Trade was solid from start to finish with only very lean sorts struggling to find new homes. Bull numbers were tight with plenty of room for more entries, especially in the black & white department.

Improved steer numbers met a tidy trade with some nice sorts penned this morning, selling to 277p/kg. Heavy bullocks sold nicely to £2038.12 in the lump.

Some great heifers in place today met a top call of 326p/kg with seven females on or above that 300p/kg figure. Heavy heifers topped at £1829.70 in the lump.

The shortage of bulls continues as producers decide to castrate their male calves and with less bull beef from the dairy herd. Heavy suckler bulls sold to 259p/kg on two occasions, with two Limousins over £2000 to £2131 in the lump.

Four top prices per kilo went to John Cantrill to a high of 277p/kg for 652kg Limousin cross 680kg Limmies from Andrew Preece sold to 258p/kg, with Mike Evan's Saler bullocks selling to 257p/kg and 256p/kg. Heavy Limousins from Gilbert Brown added up nicely to £2038.12 for 812kg, with his second to £1912.68. Salers from Mr Evans also stacked up at £1902.58.

Obituary

Geoffrey Davis Bower

Geoff moved from South Staffordshire to the Leasowes Farm just outside Bridgnorth in 1964, to start farming on his own account. This tenanted farm was purchased some years later and was built on by acquiring several neighbouring farms to develop a substantial farming business, trading as GD Bower and Sons. Farming for him was a true mixed farming business that combined dairy and beef cattle, sheep and pigs, and the arable land was used to produce feed for the stock. Geoff was a stalwart supporter of Bridgnorth Livestock Market and there would not be many weeks when he did not attend with one or more classes of stock. He did however have reservations about moving the market out of town to the new site at Tasley - perhaps concerned that the Christmas tradition of a glass of whisky and a cigar at the primestock show would end. Geoff was a true countryman and developed an interest in horse racing and hunting during his working life, which developed into a greater interest as he moved towards retirement from active farming.

Geoff passed away peacefully at home on 11th September 2022.

The family has also asked us to report that Geoff's daughter Susan Mary Knight passed away at Barnstaple Hospital on 18th September after a long struggle with cancer.
