159 PRIME CATTLE

More cattle forward as anticipated with most fieldwork drawing to an end. A very good trade on best cattle once again and with second string types well in line. We possibly need some colder weather now to help boost sale up to the festive sale period. There were more over age cattle and ordinary shaped sorts penned this morning.

Only 12 steers forward but with two or three decent types which sold to 220p/kg with 43 month bullocks to £1310.40.

Butcher heifers saw plenty of competition around the ring and as one face was missing until next week another returned. Best Continentals sold to 260p/kg and passed 250p/kg on several occasions.

With bull trade reporting cheaper markets up north, we had a decent trade with all things considered - helped by some decent quality bulls forward. Handy weight Herefords sold to 213p/kg with Holstein to 201p/kg.

10 COWS & 1 STOCK BULL

Four buyers around the ring and not much to buy! Best Continental cows sold to 149p/kg, with Simmental and Angus cross cows with flesh passed 130p/kg. Thick meat Aberdeen Angus stock bulls to 117p/kg for 1002kg.

98 CLEAN CATTLE

Only 12 steers sold to av. 161p/kg — A very mixed steer entry saw John Cantrill selling 552kg Limousins to 220p/kg, with 474kg Handy weights to 210p/kg from Tony Barker. Charolais and Limmies to 200p/kg from John Gore. 43m Limousin crosses sold to £1310.40 from Dave Bibbey, with Friesians to £1028 at 43m from the same home.

86 heifers sold to av. 204p/kg — Richard Parkes' usual quality sold to a high of 260p/kg for 490kg Lims with others to 254p/kg and 251p/kg. 478kg Blondes from Brian Watkins sold to 256p/kg to hopefully put a smile on his face! John Gore, Dave Chilton and Roger Jordin sold to 249p/kg. Heavy heifers sold to £1330 from John Jebb. Young cows and slips are included in the averages.

61 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 173P/KG



What a difference a week makes; lambs up 10p/kg on last week with quality generally down like for like on last week's entry. Quality lambs much dearer to 174p/kg twice from BJ Rodenhurst and GF Williams and a number of heavy lambs well over £80 to £89. 47kg from Stuart Moss at 170p/kg, Texels from John Pain 47kg to 166p/kg. Commercial export spec lambs generally 155p/kg to 165p/kg with a number of very lean lambs preventing the average being even better.

Lean 31kg Texels at 142p/kg, 40kg 145p/kg and several pens of 55kg plus to 147p/kg for 60.5kg Texels however, generally overweight 120p/kg to 130p/kg
