### 181 PRIME CATTLE

Good entries forward and a very good trade throughout to match. There were some super cattle penned this morning, with only a few lean sorts depleting averages, Plenty of demand on all well-finished cattle big and small, with Farm Assurance not necessarily a benefit nor a hindrance!

The largest steer entry for quite some time saw handy-weights selling to 233p/kg, with heavies to £1449. Plenty of decent meat bullocks but very few best shapes amongst them.

Plenty of good fleshed butchers heifers forward with 17 selling to 240p/kg or more, up to a market high of 253p/kg. Heavy females sold to £1380.

Good numbers of bulls with Holsteins very much to the fore. A sprinkling of suckler bulls sold to 220p/kg with heavies to £1717 in the lump. Pen after pen of black and whites saw few below 160p/kg to a high of 174p/kg and over £1100 as a whole.

### 8 COWS SOLD TO AVERAGE 80P/KG

Cow trade struggling once more with abattoirs chock a block with cows. Grand Farm Assured Charolais from Jim Taylor sold to 110p/kg for 1058kg, with others to 100p/kg from the same home. Plain cows 57p/kg - 70p/kg.

### 118 CLEAN CATTLE

**26 Steers sold to ov.av. 180p/kg** – Handy-weight 438kg Limos from Matt & Wendy Bower topped here at 233p/kg, with another to 220p/kg from the same home. 546kg Limousins also achieved 220p/kg from Alastair Beedles, with heavier Blondes 674kg to 215p/kg from Frank Millichamp 9(£1449). David Bradley's Limo steers added up nicely to £1443.18 for 718kg.

**92 Heifers sold to ov.av. 214p/kg** – A super run from Matthew Parkes saw three Limousins to 250p/kg, 251p/kg and 253p/kg, all handy-weights. Richard Parkes sold 470kg Lims to 249p/kg, with Matt Bower selling to 248p/kg. 514kg Lims to 246p/kg from Andrew Craig. Blondes 648kg to £1380.24 from Millichamp Bros, with Roger Jordin's 616kg Blue to £1361.36.

### 63 BULLS SOLD TO OV. AV. 170P/KG

Blondes from Brian Watkins headed this section at 220p/kg for 534kg, with Alastair Beedles 532kg at 219p/kg. Paul Taylor's Limmies sold to 213p/kg for 588kg, with Peter Kirton's heavies to 213p/kg for 766kg, with his 818kg shapely lad selling to 210p/kg (£1717.80).

Black and whites sold to a level trade selling to 174p/kg on two occasions from Richard Povall and Colin Evans, with Mr Evans adding his Holsteins up to a high of £1102.
