98 PRIME CATTLE – Overall average 185p/kg

A useful post-Christmas entry saw buyers keen for cattle and more cattle could have easily sold on this trade. Most regular buyers were in attendance and everybody hopes to be present next Tuesday 3rd January 2017.

Our steer entry was very mixed with well-finished cattle selling above expectations with Charolais/Galloways to 216p/kg and heavies to £1422 in the lump.

The heifer entry contained useful cattle here and there and saw butchers cattle to 251p/kg with several passed 240p/kg.

More well-finished bulls required, with bull vendors very happy today especially those selling Holsteins. Handy-weights sold to 219p/kg with heavy Continentals to £1455, with black and whites to 172p/kg.

67 CLEAN CATTLE

12 steers sold to average 183p/kg – Curly-coated Charolais from Mrs Burgoyne sold to 216p/kg and 213p/kg, with 644kg Hereford crosses to 209p/kg from John Westwood. British Blues sold to 197p/kg and 200p/kg from Phillip Terry.

55 heifers sold to av. 211p/kg – A super run from Richard Parkes sold to 251p/kg for 490kg, with others to 248p/kg and 246p/kg from the same home. Heavier Limmies from Andrew Craig and Chris Davies both sold to 243p/kg with handy-weights to 241p/kg x 3 and 240p/kg for a “very deserving cause”. Heavy Charolais to £1410 from David Preece.

31 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 178P/KG

More bulls were needed with all buyers in attendance. Roger Tomley’s Lims sold from 210p/kg to a high of 219p/kg, with Colin Evans’ British Blue crosses to 205p/kg and John Gore’s Blues to 203p/kg. Friesians to 172p/kg from Rita Corfield with others to 169p/kg from Colin Evans.
