An overall average of 266p/kg with keen competition for all lambs penned.

Best lambs over the magical 300p/kg to 309p/kg for 39kg Beltex from Pete Morris. With butchers looking for quality regardless of weight, Stuart Moss's 45kg Texels sold to £135.75.

Properly-fed, finished lambs are now trading at a real premium and with a few lean, under-finished lambs presented not detracting from the trade, the overall average is now a better reflection of the trade.

Lambs under 40kg much dearer with Welsh types 32kg lambs over 250p/kg and 39kg sold to 309p/kg. Generally 34kg to 38kg being sold from between 250p/kg and 268p/kg.
