74 PRIME CATTLE

The smallest show of cattle for quite some time following last week's dramatic slip in trade. Consequently, the best quality cattle were as dear as we have seen them selling to 275p/kg. The bull trade which took the brunt of any downturn last week, saw some improvement but was still a little lacklustre, especially on the Holsteins.

If you have cattle to market in the next few weeks it is important that you notify the auctioneers with your potential entries so that we can attempt to match numbers to buyer requirements. Do not just turn up with cattle and expect top dollar as you may be disappointed. We already have more numbers promised for next Tuesday. Producers can exert an element of price control by trimming numbers being marketed.

11 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 97P/KG

Cow trade continues on par with recent sales, with no real 'bite' or strong demand for the time being.

Well-fed Blonde x suckler cows sold to 126p/kg for 710kg from Tom Barker. 832kg Charolais sold to 111p/kg from Rob Charles, with 938kg Simmentals to 110p/kg from David Meddins. Plain steakers sold to 75p/kg for the McCall's 780kg Holstein.

CLEAN CATTLE

Only 3 steers forward despite last week's bullocks selling well in front of deadweight quotations. British Blues (non FABBL) at 646kg sold to 200p/kg from Will Hayward, with 582kg Blonde crosses sold to the same from Martin Mottershead.

44 heifers sold to average 200p/kg. 540kg Limousins from David Preece topped the day at 275p/kg, closely followed by a 496kg Limousin to 271p/kg from Miss Kirkham. Miss Kirkham also sold two tucked up females to 263p/kg and 258p/kg. 566kg red Limmies sold to 262p/kg from Roger Jordin.

27 YOUNG BULLS SOLD OV AV. 141P/KG

Most bulls penned this morning were Holsteins. Mike Halford topped this section with his shapey Limousin 514kg at 201p/kg. 662kg Charolais from Martin Morris hit the 200p/kg mark also. Friesian Holsteins sold to 143p/kg from Dave Glover at 512kg.

A slight improvement on last week to average 184p/kg and considerably more realising over 190p/kg to a top price of 211p/kg for 40.5kg Texels from RM Colebatch and heavy hoggs to £98.40 for 60kg Texels.

The general level of interest throughout the sale gave the impression that hoggs are required for both export and home markets. Although dirty hoggs are currently not too much of an issue, as the season unfolds, belly clipping could once again be a requirement.
