Very much a two tier trade in line with a two tier entry of cattle. Best quality cattle met a dearer trade especially if they ticked all the boxes for the retail butchers. Our averages bely a really good trade but unfortunately too many cattle were lean and best suited to a Friday Store Sale.

Very few good steers forward with too many very plain cattle penned depressing averages. Top call was 216p/kg, bottom price 65p/kg, so you see the situation.

Heifers averaged well over 190p/kg with some ordinary ladies here also. Top price 254p/kg with two others 250p/kg and above. Loads of others 230p/kg and above.

Bull numbers very similar with mainly Holsteins penned. Continentals sold to 210p/kg with heavy Continentals to £1469/62. Black and Whites sold reasonably well with finish and meat to 174p/kg.

24 COWS SOLD TO OV. AV. 98P/KG

Great to see a good entry of cows. Trade saw a good level of demand selling to 123p/kg for Herefords, with Angus cos to 120p/kg. A great go on meated Holsteins to 199p/kg for 834kg with Friesians to 118p/kg. So all you producers selling direct it would be great to see you on a Tuesday helping create competition in the market place.

18 STEERS SOLD TO OV.AV. 154P/KG

In truth the auctioneer should have entered half our entry in the OTM/Cull Section as our averages were distorted by the previously discussed sturdy types. Headliners were Evans (Curdale) with their shapey Blonde to 216p/kg for 610kg (£1317.60). 602kg British Blues from Rob Foxall took second spot at 199p/kg with 638kg Charolais from John Cantrill to 196p/kg. Simmentals from Raybould's stable added up to £134.10 at 726kg.

A cracking run of 11 mainly Limousins from the Parkes' brigade averaged 240p/kg although to 254p/kg + 250p/kg.
