A super number of cattle forward with plenty of meat about along with some very commercial sorts. Thumbs up to all our producers who continue to do a top job of presenting their beasts for market. Best quality cattle in strong demand once again, with cattle between 400kg and 600kg with shape in strong demand and attaining premium prices.

More steers forward met a level trade, with best quality to 225p/kg, with over-weight bullocks to £1533.40. Butchers heifers in strong demand selling to 250p/kg, with eight others 240p/kg plus. Commercial breakers sold to a similar level of trade and were more in line with the competition.

Bull numbers continue around that 50 mark with more required for regular orders. Well-finished bulls are a very tidy trade at the moment so continue to send. Shop bulls sold to 230p/kg with Friesian Holsteins selling to 168p/kg, with no good square black and whites forward.

A very firm cow trade with only foreign cows tricky. Fit Continental cows to 156p/kg and 146p/kg from Peter Raybould up to 794kg or £1213.68. Welsh Blacks to 132p/kg for 558kg. ONLY 46 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 180P/KG


