Only a small show with farmers busy in the fields and on top of their cattle. Best quality cattle seem in short supply at the moment and once again, these sold to a premium; at least as dear as recent weeks. Butchers and wholesalers report a fairly lack-lustre trade, with some good weather required to encourage al fresco dining!

Producers please note – Easter Primestock Show next week Not a bad number of steers forward saw the best to 209p/kg or £1289 in the lump, with cattle well in line or above deadweight returns.

We were genuinely short of heifers today with best quality butchers cattle selling to 250p/kg with several others passed 240p/kg. Second quality cattle not flying off the shelves but dearer than last week.

Bulls met a similar trade to recent sales, but with the very best perhaps a little easier. However, Continentals still sold to 230p/kg, with well-finished Holsteins in strong demand as per usual

ONLY 5 COWS met a strong trade selling to 164p/kg for 840kg Blonde x cows from Brian Watkins to £1377, with Farm Assurance a distinct benefit. 626kg lean steaking dairy cows to 112p/kg.

Only 20 steers sold to average 187p/kg — Handy-weight Limousins from Alastair Beedles and Charlie Sandells sold to 209p/kg and 208p/kg respectively, with 620kg Limmies to 208p/kg from Matt Bower. 546kg Lims to 202p/kg from Pater Raybould.

Only 38 heifers sold to av. 201p/kg — The smallest show number-wise for some time saw the Parkes selling to 250p/kg with two other Limmies to 245p/kg, all handy-weights. 512kg Lims from Roger Jordin sold to 245p/kg. Heavy Charolais (non-assured) sold to £1458.24 for 672kg for Nigel Fieldhouse.


