Fewer numbers forward and trade very difficult. Believe it or not, many buyers helped today and purchased when they would have well managed without! With the larger players taking large slices off deadweight values for the week, best quality, in-specification cattle still sold above these values but they had to tick all the boxes! There were several cattle over thirty months and many sorts too fat or too plain in places.

No steers over 200p/kg today with best handy weights to 197p/kg. Cattle over 700kg were less heavily discounted than expected with £1272 top price in the lump.

Best heifers sold just short of 240p/kg but with middle of the road beasts very difficult to place at satisfactory prices. Heavy heifers sold to £1285 as a whole.

Bull trade was actually in front of last week with a few good sorts forward. Sucklers sold to 201p/kg with best Friesians thin on the ground to 168p/kg. More bulls could have been sold today.

17 COWS SOLD TO AV. 97P/KG

Mainly plain and small cows forward today met a fair trade compared with beforehand. Continentals sold to 135p/kg for 676kg from Neil Perkins, with 788kg and 582kg Lims to 120p/kg from Peter Raybould and Roger Payton. Black and white cows sold to 113p/kg from Neil Madeley and Sam Jones.

MORE COWS & STOCK BULLS REQUIRED

101 CLEAN CATTLE

32 steers sold to av. 160p/kg – including a large run of nonassured Holsteins some over thirty months. Charlie Sandells topped the section at 197p/kg for 564kg, closely followed by another "deserving cause" with 618kg Lims to 190p/kg. Heavies sold to 186p/kg from John Cantrill. Holstein steers to 131p/kg for 632kg from Derek Price.

69 heifers sold to av. 183p/kg — Neil Perkins' 678kg British Blue topped the day at 239p/kg with 494kg Lims to 238p/kg from Matt Bower. 410kg Blondes took third spot at 234p/kg, with Richard Parkes' run of seven to 229p/kg and Frank Millichamp selling to 227p/kg. Again, a sprinkling of very commercial sorts diluted averages.

36 BULLS SOLD TO AV. 168P/KG


